Aims of e-conference

Scope of electronic conferencing

Potential speakers are invited to submit proposals for articles containing new studies, research or theoretical contributions relating to areas of interest. Articles should revolve mainly around the following axes:

- o Improvement of cross-border collaboration agreements;
- Transfer of educational technologies and their impact on Morocco and developing countries;
- Comparison of education systems (North / South and East / West);
- o Internationalization and societal and human values,
- o Internationalization and reforms around the world,
- o Trade and transfer of educational knowledge (public / private provision and service);
- o Educational offshoring, constraints and challenges,
- The internationalization of education and the hidden conflicts of the giants of international politics;
- o Technical Industrialization and internationalization of education;
- o Globalization and Internationalization of higher education;
- o The university and the challenges of internationalization;
- University pedagogy today and tomorrow;
- New constraints and educational purposes;
- o The new intelligences that make the professionalism of the teacher;
- o Studies and comparison of educational experiences around the world;
- Presentation of readings-analyzes of educational situations and their articulation with "Internationalization»;
- o The internationalization of education and artificial intelligence;

The topics chosen should fall under at least one of these four broad headings:

- The university and education at the center of internationalization (reforms, trends and discourse),
- ➤ The challenges of tomorrow, hope mixed with fears (futuristic studies), etc.

Abstract Specifications

Abstract content must meet the following guidelines:

- The abstract should include a brief introduction of the topic, purpose, method employed, main findings or practical implications, conclusions, and recommendations,
- The abstract should not exceed 300 words and should be original,
- A translation of the Abstract must be provided in one of the other two conference languages.
- Five key words related to the subject must be provided with the abstract.

Abstract submission details

Abstracts should:

- Be relevant and contain a complete title (up to 15 words);
- Contain the full name(s), affiliation(s), email(s) of the author(s);
- Be written in Times New Romans, 12, and 1.5-spaced; and
- Be accompanied with a one-paragraph biography of the author

- Once your proposal has been accepted for participation in the conference, an email notification will be sent to your registered email address;
- Languages used at the conference: *English*, *French and Arabic*.
- The presentation of the electronic conference via video or audio stream should take around 15 minutes.

- Authors of accepted abstracts will be invited to submit their full papers for publication in post-conference proceedings.
